Photos: *Due to the nature of online sales and with our theme of elite offerings in mind, photo quality and consignment quality is of utmost importance. Photos must be reflective of the true quality of the entry and be of high quality and resolution.*

Photos must be submitted by October 28th. Photos can be emailed to Formo@live.com, uploaded to [DropBox](#), or included with the online registration. Please include a minimum of side view, rear view and head shot.

Fitting: *To maintain uniformity across all entries, all entries must be sheared. Lambs born after September 1, 2018 should be fitted: Bodies should be clipped using fine blades, heads and legs should be carded and clipped.*

The Sale Committee retains the right to sift for photo quality or consignment quality.

Restrictions: *Open to any female born after January 1, 2015. Any female selling as bred must be confirmed bred either by Ultrasound or Blood test prior to entry.*

Guarantee: *Any female sold as bred must be guaranteed by the seller. It is the responsibility of the consignor and buyer to directly resolve any disputes. Sale management is not responsible for handling claims. If it is determined that a consignor or buyer acts fraudulently, they may be barred from participating in future events.*

Sale Order: *The sale order will be randomly generated.*

Health Papers: Buyer is responsible to coordinate with the consignor for the required paperwork.

Registration Papers: All breeding animals sold must have an American Southdown Breeders Association approved registration paper. After payment has been received, seller is responsible for transfer of registration papers to the buyer.

DNA Test Results: This sale will follow the American Southdown Association sale and futurity policies. The seller warrants to the buyer that sheep sold are free of hereditary chondrodysplasia (spider), ectodermal dysplasia (hairy lamb), and contain a minimum of one R at codon 171. Individual DNA test results are not required for animals whose genotypes can be determined from their pedigrees and are warranted and represented as such by the consignor. Sale Sponsor assumes NO liability, legal or otherwise, expressed or implied as it relates to genomic information.

Transportation after sale: Buyer is responsible for arranging transportation of the animal after the sale. Sale management will assist buyers in making transportation arrangements but will not be responsible for providing transportation of the purchase to the new owner. Please note any delivery arrangements that you would like to offer (e.g. National Sale, Big Ohio, etc.).

Important Sale Day Information:

Payment: Check or credit card. A 3% transaction fee will apply to all credit card payments. Payment is expected within 5 business days of the date of the sale; a 12% fee will be assessed for late payment. \$50 fee will be charged for checks with insufficient funds. Registration papers will not be released until the sale price and all fees have been paid in full. Failure to pay on time may result in exclusion from future sale events.
